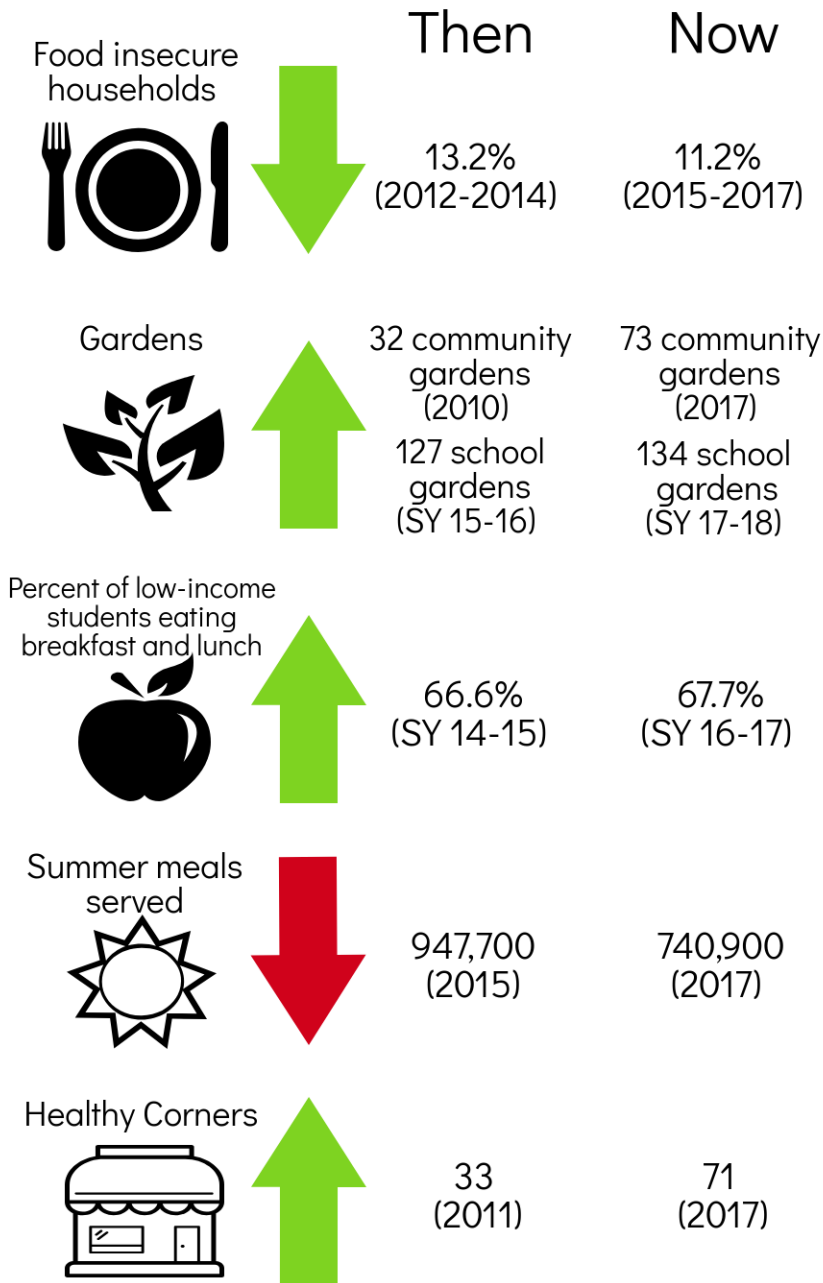


Highlights from the District's Food System Assessment (2018)
